



MINERAL SAMPLES CUSTODY POLICY

J RAMON's Policy for the custody of the mineral samples has been established based on a constant and effective communication with our Clients.

Mineral samples are property of our Clients. J RAMON assures that these samples are in due custody in our laboratory for a limited period of time specified and according to the contract.

The Commercial Coordinator is responsible of the custody of the samples of the Client prior to analysis when under J RAMON's custody. At the beginning of the contractual process the Coordinator must inform about the custody terms and conditions related to period and charges. Prior coordinations must be settled between Client and Coordinator to determine delivery and/or elimination of the samples.

As a result of the analysis process of these samples J RAMON issues a report which contents and any attachment are strictly confidential and may not be used or disclosed by other than the Client. All reports are known only by the Client and the Commercial Coordinator assigned. All remnants of the analytical samples are eliminated.

The gross samples are taken in custody for a period of 30 calendar days.

Quality samples are taken in custody for a maximum period of 180 calendar days.
